



## BORDEAUX CONTEMPORARY ARCHITECTURE

Morning or afternoon - duration: 2 hours  
Bus or bike tour

Within the quarter of Bordeaux classed as a UNESCO heritage site are not only a collection of remarkable 18th century buildings but also a range of contemporary works reflecting the dynamism and life in this sector. In fact, the last decade alone has seen several high-profile architects stake their names into the city's architectural landscape.

Discover by bike or by bus those architectural works created since the 50's.

The modernity of Bordeaux is all around us, sometimes hidden, sometimes obvious, always uniquely present. In the 1990s modernity spread once again through the city on both sides of the river.

Large-scale public facilities contributed to the development of the city in the 20<sup>th</sup> century while the tram network forms the basis for the 21<sup>st</sup> century metropolis.

The riversides have become pedestrian areas for all to enjoy with the "Miroir d'eau" (2006) conceived by the fountain engineer Jean-Max Llorca.

In the north, from the area around the lake to the wet docks with the "Cité du Vin" (2016 - XTU agency) and the recent bridge Jacques Chaban-Delmas (2013). To the east, on the opposite bank, the former army and railways facilities of la Bastide have been reclaimed to create a new residential area around the botanical gardens and the Darwin ecosystem complex.
