



SAINT-EMILION, between heritage and vineyard

Discover Saint-Emilion, a charming medieval village that has preserved its walls and gates as well as a prestigious series of archaeological monuments. It was also the first vineyard to be listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1999.

An invitation to explore the patrimony and the terroir of this is wonderful region.

Suggestion of program:

10.00 am	Leave Bordeaux with our guide and private transport
11.00 am	Tour in a cellar and wine tasting in a château
12.30 pm	Lunch – <i>Options: restaurant or lunch in a château (for this 2nd option, additional fees on request)</i>
2.30 pm	City tour of Saint-Emilion (underground monuments and the village)
5.00 pm	Back to Bordeaux

Other options – different timing:

- A second winery (same or different appellation);
- Panoramic discovery of Bordeaux (1 hour 30 in the morning);
- Château de La Brède, former house of Montesquieu, famous French philosopher and writer of the 18th century;
- Abbey of la Sauve Majeure in the Entre-Deux-Mers region: ruins quite substantial, particularly interesting examples of the Roman Art style to be seen.
