



# SAINT-EMILION, between heritage and vineyard

An invitation to share our cultural heritage and the "Bordeaux Art de vivre" in the heart of a prestigious vineyard and discovery of Saint-Emilion wines specific features.

In 1999, for the first time ever, a vineyard landscape was acknowledged as a "cultural landscape" worthy of listing as a World Heritage Site. According to UNESCO, "the Jurisdiction of Saint-Emilion is an outstanding example of an historic vineyard landscape that has survived intact and in activity to the present day."

#### 11.45 am City tour of Saint-Emilion

Saint-Emilion remains one of the most interesting towns in France because of the many old buildings confined within a very small space, and the poetic charm of its ruins. It has kept some of its fortifications: collegial church, monolithic church, the King's castle, the square steeple of the Jacobins, the town wall, and the ramparts transformed into gardens.

- Visit **Château de La Brède**, former house of Montesquieu, famous French philosopher and writer of the 18<sup>th</sup> century.
- Visit Abbey of la Sauve Majeure in the Entre-Deux-Mers region: Ruins quite substantial, particularly interesting examples of the Roman Art style to be seen. Listed as a UNESCO world heritage site on the pilgrimage route to Santiago de Compostela;
